SÃO PAULO

On January 25, 1554 the city of São Paulo was founded. On that date, the church celebrated a mass in a school near a small hill, near the Tamanduateí and Anhangabaú Rivers. The foundation of the building made by priests and native Indians became the Pateo do Collegio, one of the main tourist spots in the capital of the state of São Paulo.

In 1827, the first university in Brazil was opened, the Law School at Largo São Francisco, which became Brazil's intellectual and political hub.

With the expansion of coffee-growing in the late 19th Century, immigrants arrived from the four corners of the world to work in plantations and, later on, in the city's growing industrial complex. In 1935, the USP (University of São Paulo) was created.

In the '40s, manufacturing became the main driver in the city's economy, which boosted the labor exodus from the other Brazilian states.

In 1970, the services sector gained prominence. In nearly 500 years of history, São Paulo has established itself as Brazil's financial center.

TRANSPORTATION

SUBWAY

The fare costs BRL 4.00, and São Paulo's subway has the following lines: Blue, Green, Red, Yellow, Lilac and Silver.

The stations are open
Sunday - Friday from 4:40
am to 0:35 am, and on
Saturdays from 4:40 am to 1
am. Beware, since every day
of the week the closing time
of the stations may vary.

The ticket can be purchased at booths inside the stations.

WHERE DO THEY GO?

Blue: connects the North to the South of the city, going through Downtown.

Green: includes the South, West and part of the East areas.

Red: goes from the East end to Downtown.

Yellow: connects Downtown to the West end.

Lilac: travels through the South end of the city.

TRAIN

The railway network serves several areas of the capital and immediate surroundings through six lines: Ruby, Diamond, Emerald, Turquoise, Coral and Sapphire.
Connected to the subway, the CPTM (São Paulo Company of Metropolitan Trains) fare is BRL 4.00.

BUS

Exclusive corridors speed up the bus routes. The entire city is served by this public service, and the fare is BRL 4.00. With a Bilhete Único card it is possible to integrate travels with subway and trains, by adding an extra amount.

TRANSPORTATION

TAXI

Spread throughout several cab stands in diverse neighborhoods and the downtown area, in addition to be easily found with apps, taxis are divided into four categories: regular, radio taxi, special and luxury.

The charge is made with a system that includes the fixed fare plus an amount that varies according to mileage, day and time.

The Fare 1 starts at BRL 2.50/km (Monday - Saturday from 6 am to 8 pm) and Fare 2 from BRL 3.25/km (Monday - Saturday from 8 pm to 6 am, Sundays and Holidays).

In addition to taxis, apps such as Uber, Cabify and 99 work in the city.

CAR

For those who want to rent a car, you can count on certified car rental companies.

Marginal Tietê and Pinheiros (waterfront highways) surround the central region of São Paulo with side streets that lead to the main areas of the city. The driver should pay attention to the city license plates rotation system that is applied in the "Extended Downtown" area on Monday – Friday, from 7 am - 10 am, and from 5 pm - 8 pm. The system is not valid on Saturdays, Sundaysand Holidays.

The license plate rotation system works according to the last number of the license plate and the day of the week:



FOOD

For those who enjoy a good breakfast, visit one of the thousands of bakeries in São Paulo. Early in the morning, the typical breakfast includes a pão francês (French bread roll) with butter, requeijão (cream cheese) or cold meat (regular or grilled) and a cup of coffee, black or with milk.

Did you know that in São Paulo Wednesday is Feijoada day at lunch hour? In addition to this typical Brazilian dish, you can also find the most delicious dishes of Brazilian cuisine and of many other countries, not forgetting the contemporary cuisine that pleases the most refined tastes.

Another tip to satisfy you hunger at lunch or dinner is to enjoy a medium-cooked burger made with special meat with french fries on the side, or surrender yourself to the famous pizzas prepared in over 5,000 pizzerias.

In bars and pubs, the must-have items are pastéis, coxinhas and caipirinhas. We can't forget the traditional Bauru (French bread roll with roast beef, tomato slices, pickles and melted mozzarella cheese), the mortadella sandwich at the Mercadão Municipal and the virado à paulista (rice, beans, pork chops, sausage, pork rinds or fried bacon, kale, fried egg and banana fritters).




